strategy three

INSTITUTIONAL ADVANCEMENT

Initiative 1 Examine enrollment trends at St. Benedict, other Catholic Schools and local public schools to determine and pursue potential sources of enrollment.

Initiative 2 Guide and direct the participation of every parent, student and staff member as agents of enrollment and retention, in a broader plan of marketing and branding for the school.

Initiative 3 Ensure every employee of St. Benedict School has a well-established job description, annual goals and objectives which include routine performance reviews and development plans.

Initiative 4 Annually examine tuition rates and fees; educate prospective families about financial aid and scholarship opportunities.
